2 Baptism

- To be completely immersed in something (from Greek 'baptizo')
- A foundation doctrine of the church (Heb 6:1-2)
- Three types (baptisms) in the bible: 1. Into the body of Christ by the Holy Spirit 1Cor 12:13.... 2. In water – an outward sign of an inward experience (Rom 6:1-7) 3. With the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:8)

3 Holy Spirit Baptism

- The Holy Spirit 3rd person of the Godhead the 'doer' in charge of God's programme on the earth today
- First comes into our lives at the new birth experience He baptises us into the body of Christ (1Cor 12:13)
- Second and separate experience when we are baptised or filled with/by the Holy Spirit when He comes upon us in power (Acts 1:8, 2:1-4,)
- Subsequent infilling = continuous overflow! (Eph 5:18)

4 Receiving Holy Spirit Baptism & initial evidence of tongues

- Directly or by laying on of hands (direct: Acts 2:1-4, 10:44-46; by laying on of hands: Acts 8:14-17, 9:17 (&1cor 14:18), Acts 19:1-7)
- Believe it is for you (Acts 1:8; 2:38-39)
- Ask (Matt 7:7-8; Luke 11:13)
- Believe you receive (Mark 11:24)
- Speak (Acts 2:1-4; 10:44-46; Mark 16:17)

5 Holy Spirit & Fire

- Fire (often translating to physical heat & warmth) is a frequent manifestation of the Holy Spirit in the wilderness (Ex 13:21-22), in Sinai (Ex3:2-3)
- Prophesied by John (Matt 3:11-12; Luke 3:16)
- At Penticost tongues of fire! (Acts 2:1-4)
- The purpose of the fire is 3fold Purity (Mal 3:2, Heb 12:29), Power (Acts 1:8, 1Cor 2:4) & Passion (John 4:34, 1Cor 9:16, Jer 20:9). Fire consumes the impurities and purifies the substance or the person.

6 Fire of the Holy Spirit

- God wants us to be hot the fire of the Holy Spirit sets us ablaze and keeps our hearts pure and passionate for God and for His Kingdom(Rev 3:16)
- Fire transforms us from 'lukewarm' to being set ablaze for God (Peter Mk 14:68-72,

Acts 2:14-15 & 40-41)

- On the altar in the temple, fire was supposed to be burning 24hrs fired up every morning! (Lev 6:12)
- In the same way, the fire of the Holy Spirit is to be burning in our hearts all the time because we are the temples of God – fired for God every morning/day! (1Cor 3:16, 6:19; 2Cor 6:16)

7 - How to catch & maintain the Fire

- Be born-again into the Kingdom of God
- Receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit with initial evidence of speaking in tongues
 Pray in tongues regularly stirring up the fire!
- Have dedicated times of prayer & fasting, asking God for His fire
- Hang around people who are on fire through regular attendance in church that's on fire, friends, ministry partnerships, books & messages etc
